【전시개요】

서울의 현 갤러리에서 개최하는 「GOLD EXPERIENCE」전은、금박을 사용하여 현대적인 회화를 구축하고 있는 한일작가들의 그룹전입니다.

금박을 사용한 회화표현은、동서양을 막론하고 고대· 중세부터 오랜 역사를 지니고 있습니다. 서양에서는 템페라 기법을 주로 하는 성상화 (혹은 이콘화), 모자이크화, 벽화 등에서, 또 동양에서는 벽화나 옻칠을 하는 그림 등에서 각각의 미학이나 미적 감각, 그리고 종교나 철학을 배경으로 기법을 발전시켜왔습니다. 동양의 금박을 부착하는 방법과 서양의 금박 사용방법은 미술사에서는 전혀 다른 발전을 이루고 있지만, 근대 유럽에서는 19 세기말에 Japonisme 의 일환으로 금박을 이용한 표현이 사용되고 동양에서는 그리스도의 포교를 위한 목적으로 이콘화에서 보여지는 금박 배경이 큰 역할을 이루는 등, 동서문화의 크로스오버를 상징한다는 것으로 파악할 수 있습니다.

금박은 대체로 회화작품의 배경에 국한되어 사용되어온 것이 일반적이지만, 때로는 종교적인 숭고미를 나타내기 위해 사용된다든지, 또는 화면에서 보다 깊이 있는 공간감을 더하기 위해 사용된다든지, 작품의 소유자의 위세나 권력을 과시하기 위해서 사용되어지는 예들을 들면 회화에 있어서 금박의 소재와 기법이 달성해 온 적극적인 역할은 결코 간과할 수 없습니다.

본 전시의 목적은, 미술사에서 금박이라는 소재가 차지하는 의미나 필연을 다시한번 되새기면서, 서양과 동양에서 전혀 다른 양상을 보여온 금박 기법을, 현대미술에 있어서의 회화 작품에서 전통적으로 고스란히 이어받는 한국과 일본 작가들의 작품을 통하여 현대미술의 기법재료적인 측면에 새로움을 조명해보는 것입니다. 덧붙여서 금박에 담겨져 있는 이상과 정신성, 메시지를 되새기며 미술의 긴 역사에 이어지는 21 세기 새로운 회화 표현의 가능성에 대해 재고할 수 있는 기회를 제공하고자 합니다.

본 전시는 서울에서 개최 이후, 일본(장소, 기간미정)에서의 순회전을 가질 예정입니다.

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
